





- REASSURE YOURSELF, YOU DON'T

 NEED TO BE GOOD AT DRAWING
- DON'T WORRY ABOUT MISTAKES :
 IT'S A PART OF THE LEARNING
 PROCESS AND THEY ARE
 BEAUTIFUL!
- GIVE YOURSELF **PERMISSION** TO DRAW AND EXPERIMENT!

An experience I lived in Uxlibs as a user (trip, toilets, meals,...). Be narrative!


HOW?


This is an individual work, but you can share with the other members of your group your ideas and your feelings about the activity.
